Note on Sample Size:

The sample size for the survey was calculated with the aim of achieving an acceptable level of precision in the estimation of proportions. A half-length of 3% for the 95% confidence interval was chosen as an appropriate level of precision, and the sample size was obtained by inverting the formula for the confidence limits for a single proportion as in Lemeshow S, Hosmer DW Jr, Klar J, Lwanga SK.
