#### Studies on the use of family planning were assessed for the following empowerment and agency outcomes

- *Educational outcomes*

Measures

- Proportion of adolescents and young women currently enrolled in school
- Proportion of adolescents and young women completed school education
  - Proportion of adolescents and young women who completed primary school (up to year 5 or as defined by study authors)
  - Proportion of adolescents and young women who completed lower secondary school (up to year 10 or as defined by study authors)
  - Proportion of adolescents and young women who completed upper secondary school (up to year 12 or as defined by study authors)
- Proportion of dropouts in primary schools
- Proportion of literate (can read and write) adolescents and young people (as defined by study authors)
- *Employment outcomes*
  - Proportion of adolescents working employed
    - Proportion of adolescents and young women working full-time
    - Proportion of adolescents and young women working part-time
    - Proportion of adolescents and young women working in a casual position
- *Social outcomes*
  - Age of marriage
  - Proportion of adolescents and young women marrying below 18 years of age

*Reproductive autonomy outcomes*

- Proportion of adolescent reporting self-choice in reproductive choices
- Participation in decision making
  - Proportion of adolescents and young women had a say in choosing a partner
  - Proportion of adolescent and young women express opinions to adults
  - Proportion of adolescents and young women participate or are involved in household decision making
- Health outcomes among those who used FP methods
  - Proportion of teenage pregnancies
  - Proportion of unwanted pregnancies
  - Proportion of repeat teenage pregnancies
  - Proportion of acquisition of sexually transmitted infections
